Macro-Economic Framework Statement

A. Overview of the State Economy and GSDP Growth Rate:

The GSDP at current market prices for the year 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 was estimated at ₹34770.40 crore, ₹34718.70 crore, ₹37830.11 crore and ₹41778.77 crore respectively, registering an annual percentage growth of - 0.15 percent, 8.96 percent and 10.44 percent respectively. At constant (2011-12) market prices, the GSDP of the state during the same period was estimated at ₹24923.39 crore, ₹23750.66 crore, ₹25696.82 crore and ₹28023.72 crore with corresponding annual growth of - 4.70 percent, 8.19 percent and 9.06 percent.

The share of **Primary Sector** (Agriculture, Livestock, Forestry, Fishery and Mining & Quarrying) at current market prices GSDP accounted for 19.21 percent, 20.16 percent, 19.65 percent and 19.06 percent during the year 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 respectively. During the same period, its share of GSDP at constant (2011-12) market prices were 16.49 percent, 17.35 percent, 16.69 percent and 15.87 percent respectively.

The **Secondary Sector** contributed 16.43 percent in 2019-20, 16.46 percent in 2020-21, 16.85 percent in 2021-22 and 17.13 percent in 2022-23, to the GSDP at current market prices. At constant (2011-12) market prices, its contribution were 16.78 percent, 17.22 percent, 17.77 percent and 18.54 percent during the same period.

The **Service/Tertiary Sector** being the major contributor towards the economy of the state contributed 57.66 percent in 2019-20, 55.82 percent in 2020-21, 55.53 percent in 2021-22 and 55.76 percent in 2022-23 to the GSDP at current market prices. At constant (2011-12) market prices, its contribution during the same period were 59.80 percent, 57.56 percent, 57.45 percent and 57.78 percent respectively.

The **Per Capita GSDP** at current market prices stood at ₹97,615/-, ₹95,433/-, ₹1,01,776/- and ₹1,10,002/- during 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-23 respectively, showing an annual increase of -2.24 percent, 6.63 percent and 8.08 percent. The estimates of per capita GSDP at constant (2011-12) market prices during the same period were ₹69,970/-, ₹65,285/-, ₹69,133/- and ₹73,785/- with the corresponding annual growth of -6.69 percent, 5.89 percent and 6.72 percent during the same period respectively.

Although, COVID-19 pandemic had inflicted disturbances in the health and economic activities of the state, however, the economy showed signs of recovery during the mid-half of 2021 and improved the GSDP of the State.

As the economy of the State is on the path of recovery, the following assumptions were made in estimating the State's GSDP:

With regards to the Primary sector, the growth in GSDP from this sector is estimated at about 7.10 percent during 2022-23 as compared to a growth of 6.23 percent in 2021-22.

The growth of GSDP from Manufacturing and Construction activities are estimated at a positive growth of 11.52 percent in 2021-22 and 12.27 percent in 2022-23, thereby affecting a growth in the Secondary Sector, i.e. an increase from ₹ 6375.15 crore in 2021-22 to ₹7157.18 crore in 2022-23.

Services/Tertiary sector is estimated to register a positive growth of 10.91 percent during 2022-23 i.e. an increase from ₹21007.07 crore in 2021-22 to ₹23299.63 crore in 2022-23.

Overview of the State Government Finances:

The State had a revenue surplus of ₹653.91 crore during 2021-22 (Actual) as the revenue receipt of ₹14274.14 crore is more than revenue expenditure of ₹13620.23 crore during the year. Moreover during 2022-23 (RE) the State is also estimated to have a revenue surplus of ₹1496.79 crore.

The State has a revenue surplus during 2021-22 (Actual) of ₹653.91 crore as compared to the revenue deficit of ₹815.37 crore during 2020-21 (Actual). As a result, this impacted the fiscal deficit and therefore decreased the fiscal deficit to ₹2358.81 crore during 2021-22 against ₹2603.55 crore deficit of the previous year. The Fiscal Deficit during 2022-23 (RE) is estimated to decrease to ₹1861.01 crore.

The Primary Deficit was ₹1395.53 crore during 2021-22 (Actual) and is estimated to increase to ₹831.95 crore during 2022-23.

- C. The State had a revenue surplus of ₹653.91 crore during 2021-22 on account of increase in receipt from the share in central taxes, and the increase in Central transfer of funds. The State is also estimated to have a revenue surplus during 2022-23 (RE), 2023-24 (BE) on account of the increase in the earmarked of share in central taxes and increase in central transfer of funds. A revenue surplus is also estimated for the next three years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27.
- D. The fiscal deficit during 2021-22 is 6.24 percent of GSDP as compared to 7.79 percent during 2020-21 as the GSDP of the State increase from ₹33435.92 crore during 2020-21 to ₹37830.11 crore during 2021-22. For 2022-23, the fiscal deficit is estimated at 4.45 percent of GSDP. The State Government, as per recommendation of the Fifteenth Finance Commission and in line with the direction of the Government of India, amended the Meghalaya Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 through the Meghalaya Act No.12 of 2022 fixing the fiscal deficit at 4 percent of GSDP during 2022-23 which is inclusive of 0.50 percent of GSDP allowed to State, as additional borrowing linked to performance in the power sector. Thus, the overall fiscal deficit limit for the State was fixed at 4 percent of GSDP for 2022-23. The fiscal deficit during 2023-24 (BE) is estimated at 3.42 percent of GSDP and it is estimated at 3.23 percent, 2.95 percent and 2.81 percent of GSDP by 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27, respectively.
- E. The total liabilities as a percentage of GSDP are 40.92 percent during 2021-22 (Actual). The same is estimated at 41.67 percent of GSDP during 2022-23. The total liabilities are estimated at 39.91 percent of GSDP during 2023-24 (BE). In the next three years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27, the liabilities are estimated at 37.97 percent, 36.03 percent and 34.14 percent respectively.

Assumptions made in connection with the estimates on the Medium Term Fiscal Policy:

1. Receipts:

(a) Revenue Receipts: The State's Own Tax Revenue was ₹2300.38 crore in 2021-22 (Actual), it is estimated to increase to ₹2635.51 crore during 2022-23 (RE) and ₹3204.66 crore during 2023-24 (BE). In the next three years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27, the State's Own Tax Revenue is estimated at ₹3525.13 crore, ₹3877.64 crore and ₹4265.40 crore respectively.

The State's Own Non-Tax Revenue was ₹524.58 crore in 2021-22 (Actual), this is estimated to increase to ₹590.21 crore during 2022-23 (RE) and ₹742.59 crore during 2023-24 (BE). In the next three years, 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27, the State's Own Non-Tax Revenue is estimated at ₹824.51 crore, ₹915.47 crore and ₹1016.46 crore respectively.

The State's Share of Central Taxes was ₹6580.63 crore in 2021-22 (Actual). It was estimated at ₹7386.14 crore during 2022-23 (RE) and ₹7834.51 crore during 2023-24 (BE). The State's share of Central Taxes is estimated at ₹8866.34 crore, ₹10034.05 crore and ₹11355.57 crore during 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively.

Other Central transfers such as grants under Finance Commission, Central Sector and Centrally Sponsored Schemes, NEC, NLCPR and EAPs, etc, was ₹4868.57 crore in 2021-22 (Actual). This is estimated at ₹7034.23 crore in 2022-23 (RE) and ₹7632.57 crore in 2023-24 (BE). In the next three years, 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 Central transfers are estimated at ₹8289.73 crore, ₹8425.37 crore and ₹9115.69 crore respectively.

(b) Capital Receipts: The total capital receipt was ₹2316.93 crore in 2021-22 (Actual). This is estimated at ₹2042.68 crore in 2022-23 (RE) and ₹2042.73 crore during 2023-24 (BE). The capital receipt is projected at ₹2103.69 crore, ₹2311.76 crore and ₹2654.76 crore during the next three years, 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively. Borrowings constitute a major part of capital receipt, it was ₹2292.52 crore during 2021-22(Actuals), ₹2020.00 crore during 2022-23 (RE) and is estimated at ₹2015.08 crore during 2023-24 (BE). Borrowings are projected at ₹2075.53 crore, ₹2283.09 crore and ₹2625.55 crore during 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively.

2. Expenditure:

- (a) Revenue Expenditure: The Revenue Expenditure was ₹13620.23 crore in 2021-22 (Actual). The expenditure is estimated at ₹16149.30 crore during 2022-23 (RE) and ₹17186.07 crore during 2023-24 (BE). The Revenue Expenditure is projected at ₹19076.54 crore, ₹20411.90 crore and ₹22555.14 crore during the next three years 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively.
- (b) Capital Expenditure: The total capital expenditure was ₹3525.91 crore in 2021-22 (Actual). The expenditure is estimated to increase to ₹3966.70 crore in 2022-23 (RE) and ₹4512.70 crore during 2023-24 (BE). The same is projected at ₹4810.40 crore, ₹5274.97 crore and ₹5759.72 crore during 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively.

3. Outstanding liabilities:

The Outstanding liabilities were 40.92 percent of GSDP during 2021-22 (Actual). The liabilities are estimated at 41.67 percent during 2022-23 (RE) and 39.91 percent during 2023-24 (BE). The same are projected at 37.97 percent, 36.03 percent and 34.14 percent of GSDP during 2024-25, 2025-26 and 2026-27 respectively.

Fiscal Policy Strategy Statement

A. Fiscal Policy Overview: The fiscal policy during 2021-22 continue to be influenced by the impact of the COVID -19 pandemic as the total expenditure increased from ₹13314.56 crore in 2020-2021 to ₹16657.36 crore in 2021-22 to contain and manage the pandemic. Much of the increase of the above expenditure of the State Government had been met by way of borrowing which the Government of India has facilitated by increasing the net borrowing limit of the state from 3 percent of GSDP to 4.5 percent of GSDP during 2021-22. With the economy showing signs of recovery during 2022-23 as reflected by the growth of GSDP, the revenue of the State is expected to improve during the year, which would enable the State to have a revenue surplus and a fall in the fiscal deficit to 4.45 percent of GSDP.

As per recommendation of the Fifteenth Finance Commission and in line with the direction of the Government of India, the State Government, amended the Meghalaya Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 through the Meghalaya Act No.12 of 2022 fixing the fiscal deficit at 4 percent of GSDP during 2022-23 which is inclusive of 0.50 percent of GSDP allowed to State as additional borrowing linked to performance in the power sector. Thus, the overall fiscal deficit limit for the State was fixed at 4 percent of GSDP for 2022-23.

B. Fiscal Policy for the ensuing financial year: The fiscal policy for 2023-24 will continue to be guided by the recommendation of the 15th Finance Commission and the objectives of the FRBM Act, 2006 (Principal Act) that is to: (a) generate revenue surplus and reduce the fiscal deficit and also to build up adequate surplus for discharging the committed liabilities and for developmental expenditures; (b) pursue policies to raise tax and non tax revenue with due emphasis on cost recovery and equity; (c) prioritize capital expenditure and (d) pursue an expenditure policy that would provide impetus for economic growth with social equity and improvement in poverty reduction and human welfare.

- 1. Tax Policy and Non Tax Policy: The State Government will continue with its regular review of revenue collection of major revenue earning Departments to identify and introduce new revenue collection measures to augment the State's Own resources.
- 2. Expenditure Policy: Apart from making adequate provision for meeting committed liabilities such as salaries, pension, interest payment and repayment of loans and advances, the Government will continue to provide adequate resources for expenditure on social and economic infrastructure, along with tourism, agriculture and allied activities and industries, which are sectors that have the potential to provide livelihood and employment opportunities.
- **3. Borrowings:** The debt policy of the Government will be guided by the fiscal targets fixed by the FRBM Act with due regard to financial implications on the future generation and the fiscal deficit targets.
- 4. Consolidated Sinking Fund: During 1999-2000 the State Government constituted the 'Consolidated Sinking Fund' for redemption and amortization of open market loan to avoid future dislocation in the management of Debt. An amount of ₹68.65 crore was contributed during 2021-22 (Actual). Closing balance in the Fund till the end of 2021-22 is ₹882.12 crore. An amount of ₹77.41 crore is estimated for contribution to the Fund during the fiscal year, 2022-23 and ₹87.06 crore during 2023-24 (BE).
- 5. Contingent and other Liabilities: Though at present there is no statutory limit as to the outstanding amount of contingent liabilities, the State is guided by the fiscal targets stipulated by the FRBM Act, 2006, i.e. restricting the issue of guarantees, except on selective basis where the viability of the scheme to be guaranteed is assured and the scheme is beneficial to the State. To service contingent liabilities arising out of the invocation of State Government Guarantees, the Government constituted the 'Guarantee Redemption Fund' in 2014-15 managed by the Reserve Bank of India. Balance in the Fund as at the end of 2021-22 is ₹61.54 crore. An amount of ₹14.90 crore is estimated for contribution during 2022-23 (RE) and also ₹14.90 crore during 2023-24 (BE).
- 6. Levy of User Charges: At present, not much revenue is raised by the State Government from user charges, except for a nominal amount from Government school fees, hospital charges, house water connection in urban areas, etc.
