OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Supply of light refreshment/lunch at meeting.

In partial modification of this Office Memorandum No.FC(I)1601/93 dated 21.3.94, it has been observed that the expenditure on Light Refreshment/Lunch served at Meetings convened by the Government is increasing. As Government desire that utmost economy should be observed in incurring such expenditure , the following instructions are issued for the guidance of all concerned.

- 1. Tea or Coffee and Light Refreshment/Lunch may be served at:
 - i. Committees, Conferences and Meetings convened by the Govt. and <u>attended by officials and Non-Officials</u>.
 - ii. Tender/Purchase Board Committee Meetings, duly constituted by Govt. and attended by Members/representatives of the concerned Departments.
 - iii. Conference of discussions attended by <u>officials of the Central</u> <u>Govt. or other State Govt.</u>
 - iv. In case of important meeting like the meeting of the State Planning Board.
- 2. Ordinarily refreshments should be serve once when a meeting or conference continuous for not less than one hour. There may be no objection, however, to a second service if the meeting continue for more than 4 hours.
- 3. The expenditure on this account is restricted to Rs.5/- per head each time. Any departure from this rate should have the prior approval of Finance Department
- 4. The expenditure on supply of lunch is restricted to Rs.60/- per head each time.
- 5. For meetings other than those convened by the Ministers/Chairman/Dy.Chairman/Chief Secretary/Addl. Chief Secretary, the decision to provide refreshment should be taken with the Secretary/Commissioner approval of the Principal and Secretary/Secretary Department convening of the such meeting/conference. The Nazir, Govt. of Meghalaya, Secretariat Administration Department (N) will make necessary arrangement for the purpose.

- 6. The expenditure incurred in this respect is debitable to the respective head of accounts.
- 7. Subject to the above conditions the concurrence of Finance will not be necessary.
