OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject :- Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACPS) – matters relating thereto.

Attention of the State Government has been drawn to provisions of Para 2(4) of O.M. No.F(PR)-76/2009/54 dated 22.2.2010 which does not allow stepping up of pay to the senior employee on the ground that the junior employee in the cadre has got higher pay under the Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACPS).

After due consideration of the matter, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to decide that Para 2(4) of the aforesaid Office Memorandum be relaxed and stepping up of pay of the senior employee to that of the junior employee be allowed on case to case basis provided they belong to the same cadre.

The cases agreed earlier by Finance (Pay Revision) Department prior to issue of this Office Memorandum have also been regularised by the Cabinet.
